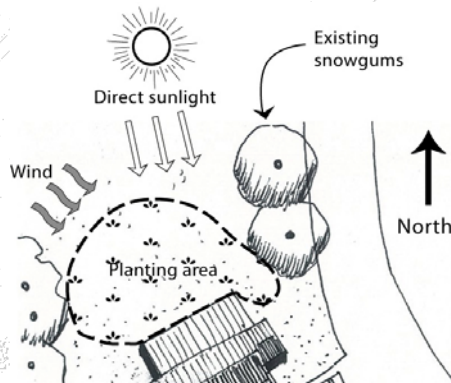
Dinner Plain planting suggestions.

The plant communities of Dinner Plain are primarily Snowgum Woodland and Open grassland. The following plants are recommended for the particular micro environments typical throughout the village.

Snowgum Woodland

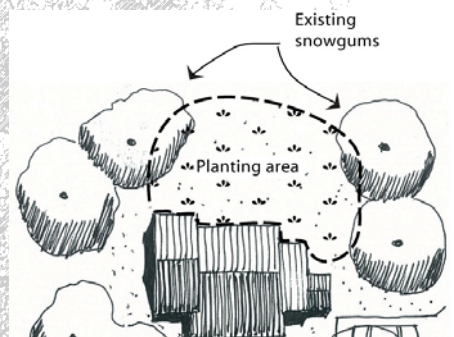
1) Exposed site – direct sun and wind:

Snow gum,
Alpine Grevillea,
Rusty Pods, Alpine Phelbalium,
Snow grass (poa sp) Scaly buttons,
Billy Buttons, Spoon Daisy,
Chamomile Sunray,
Senecio,
Orange Everlasting



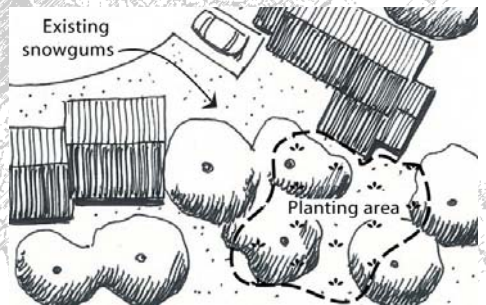
2) Open woodland – Few trees with majority open space:

Snow gum,
Olearia erebesens, Alpine Grevillea,
Dusty Daisy bush, Pimelea axiflora,
Derwents Speedwell, Snow grass (poa sp),
Pale everlasting, Silky Snow Daisy,
Clustered Everlasting, Chamomile Sunray,
Cushion Plant, Trigger plant,
Spoon Daisy, Luzula.



3) Sheltered woodland – Abundant tree canopy:

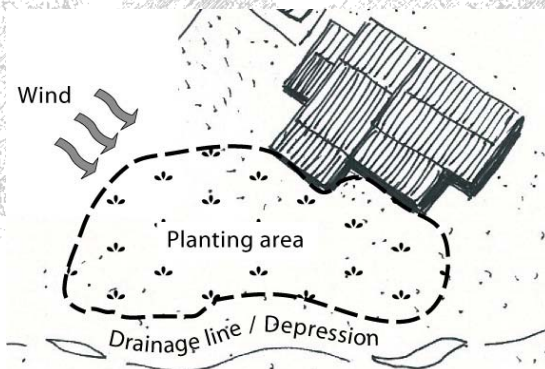
Mountain Pepper, Olearia erebesens, Dusty Daisy bush
Pimelea axiflora, Derwents Speedwell, Ledge Grass,
Silky Snow Daisy, Clustered Everlasting,
Chamomile Sunray, Pale everlasting,
Orange Everlasting, Pale Vanilla Lily



Open grassland

1) Cold / moist e.g., drainage area:

Ledge grass, Snow grass (poa sp),
Billy Buttons,
Pale everlasting
Chamomile Sunray.



2) Dry exposed site

Snow grass (poa sp), Billy Buttons, Pale everlasting, Silky Snow Daisy, Scaly buttons, Orange Everlasting
