KERBSIDE PRUNING COLLECTION

Council offers an annual collection of garden prunings from residents' naturestrips.

Collection will take place at:

Myrtleford:

Monday 11 – Friday 15 July 2022

Mount Beauty and Tawonga:

Monday 18 – Friday 22 July 2022

Bright, Porepunkah and Wandiligong:

Monday 25 – Friday 29 July 2022

- Prunings will only be collected once per household on or near the date specified for each township. Households placing unacceptable material or not abiding by the timetable will be responsible for removing these items from the road reserve.
- Prunings placed on a nature strip too early will constitute a local law infringement i.e. no more than one week prior to the collection week.
- This collection program is for PRIVATE TREE PRUNINGS ONLY. Pruning of Council owned trees will constitute a local law infringement. Residents will be responsible for the removal of Council-owned trees in this instance.
- Prunings must be:
 - Neatly stacked with ends facing the kerbside on the nature strip, not obstructing vehicular or pedestrian traffic
 - Have a minimum diameter of 20mm for each pruning
 - Have a maximum diameter of 200mm for each pruning
 - Be maximum three cubic metres total loose volume
 - On the nature strip by the specified date
 - Not bound by wire

The following materials WILL NOT be collected or chipped:

- Vines and creepers
- Blackberries, roses, bamboo, flax and palms
- Tree stumps, and tree roots
- Spiky citrus varieties
- Wire, string, metal, plastics etc.
