ASPHALTING AND RESEALING WORKS

Asphalting and resealing works will be

The Clyde Street traffic lane from Standish
Street will be closed between 9am and
approximately 12 pm.

The Clyde Street traffic lane from Myrtle
Street will be closed from approximately
12pm to 5pm.

A part road closure on Queen Street will
be in place from 9am to 5pm. Access to
the open section of Queen Street will be
available via Elgin Street and Rayner Street.
