



ASPHALTING AND RESEALING WORKS

Asphalting and resealing works will be carried out in the Lower Ovens area from Monday, 7 March for approximately four weeks.

Alpine Shire Council advises that there will be traffic control measures in place for a short time during these works. These traffic control measures may result in interruptions to traffic and parking.

There will be half road closures in Myrtleford at the Clyde Street/Queen Street intersection on the morning of Sunday, 20 March for asphalting works.

The Clyde Street traffic lane from Standish Street will be closed between 9am and approximately 12pm.

The Clyde Street traffic lane from Myrtle Street will be closed from approximately 12pm to 5pm.

A part road closure on Queen Street will be in place from 9am to 5pm. Access to the open section of Queen Street will be available via Elgin Street and Rayner Street.
