DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL AND REASON FOR APPLICATION
ASSESSMENT CRITERIA
The Minister for Planning in his Minister's Guideline (MG/12 dated June 2006) has set out the objective and decision guidelines that Council must have in regard to when considering varying a design and siting standard.
Note: If any matter set out in the guideline is not met, then Council <u>must refuse</u> consent.
Objective: To ensure that the location, length and height of a wall on a boundary respects the existing or preferred neighbourhood character and limits the impact on the amenity of existing dwellings.
<b>Decision Guidelines:</b> The reporting authority may give its consent where a single dwelling, does not comply with <i>regulation 80 of the Building Regulations 2018</i> , if -
(a) the location, length and or height of the wall will be appropriate taking into account the prevailing location, length and or height of boundary walls of existing buildings on nearby allotments; or

(b) the location, length and or height of the wall will be more appropriate taking into account the preferred character of the area where it has been identified in the relevant planning scheme; or

(c) the slope of the allotment and or existing retaining walls or fences reduces the effective height of the building; or
