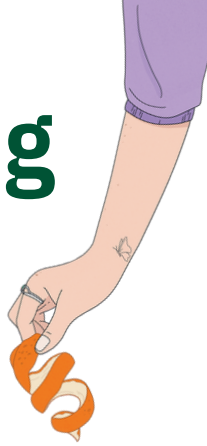


Start using your new bin!



Your new 240L green-lid Food Organics and Garden Organics bin, bench-top kitchen caddy and a 1 year supply of certified caddy liners have arrived!

Your collection day does not change!

Each week your green-lid FOGO bin will be out with either the yellow-lid recycling bin or the red-lid general waste bin. Your recycling bin will continue to be collected on the same fortnight, and your general waste bin will now be collected on the opposite fortnight.

Unsure about which bins go out on collection day? Scan the QR code and enter your address to find out what your collection day is for your bins!



Nappies

To prevent nappy odour in your waste bin:

- Store your red-lid waste bin in the shade.
- Double bag your nappies.
- Dispose of any solid waste in the toilet before putting nappies into your red-lid waste bin.
- Use odour removing products such as odour removal crystals or bin fresheners.

Keep me!
Put this flyer on your fridge or somewhere handy!

Putting your bin out

Put your bin out the night before collection day.

- Bring it in when it's empty (within 24 hours).
- Place your bin on the kerbside along the road, away from any obstructions (trees, poles, signs).
- Place your bins at least 1m apart.
- Make sure it faces toward the road (the handle should face your home).
- Don't overfill your bin - make sure the lid can close! Maximum weight 80kg.

Food and garden organics

Weekly service

Food organics, accepted household items and garden organics only. Remove packaging, rubber bands and stickers from fruit.

Accepted items

This is not a full list

- Out of date, inedible food
- Coffee grounds
- Paper towel, facial tissues
- Dairy products including yoghurt
- Fruit and vegetable waste
- Meat, seafood, bones, egg shells
- Leaves, plants, twigs, grass, noxious weeds



Not accepted

Plastic, including biodegradable or non-certified compostable plastics, coffee pods, treated timber, clothing, nappies, wet wipes, recyclable materials or hazardous waste.

Mixed recycling

Fortnightly service

Items must be loose and clean of food scraps when placed in this bin. Do not put them in plastic bags. Flatten boxes to save space.

Accepted items

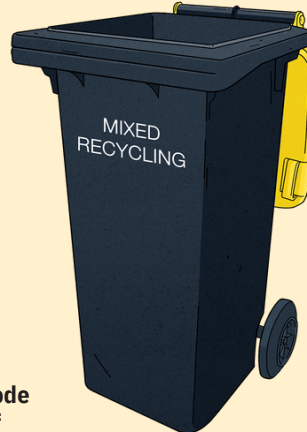
This is not a full list

- Accepted plastic bottles and containers
- Aluminium and steel tins, cans, foil
- Glass bottles and jars
- Cardboard, cereal boxes, egg cartons
- Paper, newspapers, magazines, paper envelopes



Not accepted

Plastic bags, other soft plastics, clothing, shoes, textiles, coated or waxed cardboard, electronic waste and batteries, crockery, polystyrene (styrofoam), coffee cups or hazardous waste.

General waste

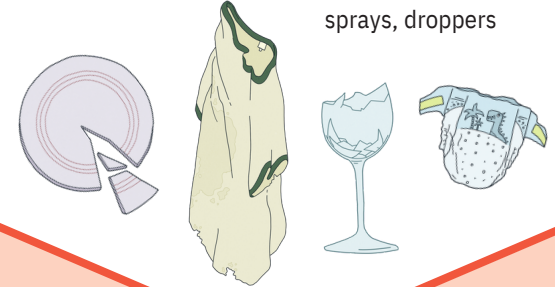
Fortnightly service

Use this bin for items that can't be reused or recycled. Food waste no longer goes in this bin.

Accepted items

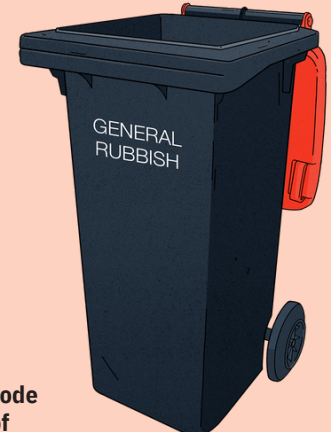
This is not a full list

- Broken glassware, crockery and mirrors
- Nappies and wet-wipes
- Old clothing, shoes or textiles that can't be repaired or donated
- Loose jar lids and bottle caps, pumps, sprays, droppers



Not accepted

Electronic waste and batteries, food and garden waste, household chemicals, recyclable items, soil, building materials or hazardous waste.
