

APPLICATION FOR A FARM RATE

The following submission is to have our land classified as "Farmland" as defined in Council's Farm Rate Policy, as detailed below:

Scope

The policy applies to Council when considering and determining the annual budget of rates and charges. It does not apply to land located in Bogong Village or the Dinner Plain Village.

Policy details

A differential rate is applied to farmland at 73% of the general rate. An application must be made to change the classification of a property to the differential farm rate and will not be applied retrospectively.

'Farmland' means any rateable land which satisfies the following criteria:

The land area must be of 8Ha or over; or

- be used primarily for grazing (including agistment), dairying, pig-farming, poultry farming, fish farming, tree farming, bee keeping, viticulture, horticulture, fruit growing or the growing of crops of any kind or for any combination of those activities; and
- show that the primary source of income is derived from the land; and

The land must be used by a business that:

- has a significant and substantial commercial purpose or character; and
- seeks to make a profit on a continuous or repetitive basis from its activities on the land; and
- is making a profit from its activities on the land, or that has a reasonable prospect of making a profit from its activities on the land if it continues to operate in the way it is operating.
